



Analysis of the Management of Sports Facilities and Infrastructure at the UPTD Kebatakan Sports of West Sumatra Province

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ABSTRACT

The increase in sports achievements obtained by West Sumatra Province was influenced by many factors, one of which was the sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD of West Sumatra Province's Talent Sports. The aim of the study was to find out how the management of sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD Kebatakan Sports of West Sumatra Province can increase achievement. The method used in this research is the descriptive-qualitative method. Sources of research data are the management of sports facilities and infrastructure and documentation. The results of the study show that the completeness of the management of facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD of Sports Talent in the Province of West Sumatra is a factor in increasing achievement. planning in collaboration with the government of West Sumatra Province. Organising (organizing), which is directly led by the manager, preparation of personnel (staffing) according to employee recruitment standards, directing (directing), which is carried out directly by the manager, and supervision (controlling) are carried out at any time. The conclusion in this study is that the management of sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD of Sports Talent in the Province of West Sumatra in improving sports achievement in the Province of West Sumatra is a supporting factor for the positive outcome of the event. It is recommended to add sports facilities and infrastructure, such as rubber jogging tracks, and improve the organisational system according to the sports sector.

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INTRODUCTION

Facilities are equipment for various items, such as materials or furniture, that are directly used in an activity or activities. So, sports facilities are anything that can be used and utilised



in the process of carrying out sports activities and that can be moved and carried by sports actors (Bafadal, 2011). As an open space, the infrastructure developed must be able to facilitate and accommodate the needs of the whole community to exercise, such as children, youth, parents, even the elderly, and people with special needs, both men and women (Mutohir, & Maksum, 2007). Organisations in the field of sports need the support of good facilities and infrastructure in order to produce outstanding athletes.

One of the organisations engaged in sports is the Student Education and Training Centre (PPLP) of West Sumatra Province. The West Sumatra Province Student Education and Training Centre (PPLP), located in the city of Padang, is a forum for the interests and talents of the West Sumatra Province to develop student achievement in all sports at the West Sumatra Province Student Education and Training Centre (PPLP). The existence of the West Sumatra Province Student Education and Training Centre (PPLP) in the city of Padang is one of the strategic facilities for fostering the potential of the West Sumatra Province specifically for all sports. The age of students is the golden age for achievement in all sports.

At the Student Education and Training Centre (PPLP) of West Sumatra Province in Padang City, this is divided into several sports that are adjusted to the abilities of these athletes. Athletes who take part in training at the Student Education and Training Centre (PPLP) of West Sumatra Province come from various regions in West Sumatra as well as from different social levels and with different characters. The difference in character that each athlete has must be able to be understood by the coach so that the coach is able to align the athlete's training goals as a whole for the purpose of achievement.

Based on observations and interviews conducted with staff and athletes at the UPTD Sports Talent in West Sumatra Province, information was obtained that when participating in events such as the National Sports Week (PON) in 2021, the number of medals obtained by athletes was still not large; this can be seen in the number of medals won in each branch competing.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

This research method is used to solve or answer problems that are being faced in the current situation (Notoatmojo, 2005). The method used in this study is a qualitative method in accordance with the problems, and the purpose of this study is descriptive-qualitative. This qualitative method is used for many reasons. First, adapting qualitative methods is easier when dealing with multiple realities. Second, this method directly presents the nature of the relationship between researchers and respondents. Third, this method is more sensitive and more able to adapt to the many sharpenings of joint influence on the value patterns encountered (Moleong, 2010). This type of research or research method is a method used by researchers to collect research data (Suharsimi, 2006). Basically, scientific research is an attempt to find, develop, and test the truth of a science that is done to achieve a goal. The research method, also referred to as a method or steps used by researchers, is a qualitative descriptive research method. Descriptive research is a study that seeks to describe objects or subjects that are examined objectively, with the aim of systematically describing facts and the characteristics of objects and frequencies that are examined precisely (Zellatifanny & Mudjiyanto, 2018). In this study, qualitative research using descriptive methods was used. According to Sugiyono (2016), a qualitative research method is a research method that is used to examine the conditions of natural objects where the researcher is the key instrument or the main instrument.

Data analysis in qualitative research is carried out inductively; the interpretation applies specifically because there are limits determined by focus. Data analysis activities in this study that were used by researchers were reading, observing, understanding, and studying

carefully all the data that had been collected, which was obtained from the results of interviews, observation, documentation, and literature study. The following stages of data analysis were carried out, namely: 1) *Data reduction*. Data reduction is the process of selecting, focusing on, abstracting, and transforming raw data from the field. This process lasts as long as the research is carried out, from the beginning to the end of the research. Its function is to sharpen, classify, direct, remove unnecessary information, and organise so that interpretation can be drawn; 2) *Data presentation*. The presentation of good data will be easy to see, read, and understand. The presentation of data that is often used in qualitative methods is in the form of narrative text. The presentation of good data includes various types of matrices, graphs, and charts, all of which are neatly arranged in an integrated form, making it easy to understand; 3) *Draw conclusions or verify*. Conclusions or verification in this study depend on the completeness of data collection in the field. The conclusion of qualitative data analysis activities lies in the description of what is produced so that it can be understood with respect to the problem being examined. The ability of the researcher will play a very important role in detailing, tracking, recording, and organising any relevant data for an in-depth study.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Referring to the analysis of the research results mentioned above, it can be stated that the increase in achievement in West Sumatra Province is measured by the medals won by athletes from West Sumatra Province who take part in championships because, so far, the progress of sports in an area tends to be based on the acquisition of medals in multi-event activities, according to Mutohir & Maksum (2007). Assessing sporting success is the acquisition of medals in an event. Such a measure is certainly not wrong, but it is also not entirely correct. This is because, in every multi-event match, the acquisition of medals is indeed a measure of the success of a region or country in developing its sporting achievements. Achievement sports are arenas with a very competitive nature. Successful athletes are those with the best qualifications. Improved performance in general can also be measured by fostering long-term achievements in a tiered and sustainable manner.

The long-term development of athletes must begin with the development of a sports culture, which begins with increasing access to quality physical education and sports in various ways. The pattern of coaching goes from instilling general basic movement patterns (multilateral development) to sports specialists. Multiple development (multi-ability), which includes physical, mental, social, personal, cognitive, and creative aspects, needs to be considered in the physical education and sports curriculum and training. Long-term development of athletes whose planning is adjusted to the level of growth and development (long-term, developmentally appropriate planning of training).

Efficiency in the utilisation of all resources needs to be a prioritised part of the implementation of coaching. In this regard, it is necessary to optimise the utilisation of all PPLP coaching pathways (student pathways). This multi-track system has been implemented and needs to be continuously strengthened by providing broad opportunities and access so that each member can practice with the support of reliable trainers as well as broad and flexible support to participate in various competitions according to the level and type of sport (Mutohir & Maksum, 2007).

Leadership style is determined by various factors, including personal background, personal education, experience, and the environment one faces. In accordance with the meaning of leadership according to Patrusi (2012), leadership is a process of influence from leaders who make other people willing to do what they should do well.

The management of sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD of Sporting Skills of West Sumatra Province is going quite well because the Head of Section (KASI), who serves as the manager of sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD of Sports Skills of the Province of West Sumatra, is involved in the development of sports facilities and infrastructure at the Provincial UPTD of Sports Skills. Every year in West Sumatra, there are repairs or renovations to venues or areas, addition of sports training facilities, security facilities in the form of CCTV (close circuit television) installation, development of aspects of sports achievements for athletes, and making the area at the UPTD Kebakatan Sports of West Sumatra Province good.

The West Sumatra Provincial Government is a source of funds for the management of the West Sumatra Provincial UPTD Talent in Sport budget that will be used for the development of sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD Talent in Sport of West Sumatra Province. The organisation that is implemented by the management of sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD Kebakatan Sport in West Sumatra Province is a task that is given by the manager to staff by forming a venue or area coordinator for each field who is responsible for the tasks set by the manager. Management of each venue or area that has been determined by the manager with criteria and an understanding of the characteristics of the venue or area. The direction carried out by the management of sports facilities and infrastructure at the West Sumatra Provincial UPTD Sports Talent is by giving direction to the duties and authorities according to the manager and the field coordinator leader.

The field coordinator will go directly to the field to convey the tasks that have been given by the manager for each venue or area. Activities to be carried out at the West Sumatra Provincial UPTD Talent Sports in the form of sports events must go through permission from the manager of sports facilities and infrastructure at the Provincial UPTD Kebakatan Sports West Sumatra, namely the Head of the UPTD and the Head of the Section. The manager gives orders to security officers and field coordinators to prepare and ensure the security of each venue or area that will be used for an event.

Implementation of the personnel preparation process in order to achieve the goals that have been determined by adding several officers to support the running of the management at the UPTD Kebakatan Sports, West Sumatra Province Management cooperates with other administrators to create questions that will be used for the selection test. The test was carried out in the form of questions containing basic material on management and environmental knowledge at the UPTD Sports Talent in the Province of West Sumatra, as well as conducting interview tests to improve the quality of management at each venue or area in the UPTD Sports Talent in the Province of West Sumatra.

Exercise can increase resistance to stress. The results of the study prove that adolescents who are involved in physical activity are more resilient and able to cope with stressors from their environment, according to Mutohir and Maksum(2007). Sports that are carried out systematically, regularly, and purposefully will greatly help our efforts to create a healthy and quality lifestyle. Sports achievements at the West Sumatra Provincial Student Education and Training Centre are a positive achievement in the championship because the management of sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD Talent in Sports of the Province of West Sumatra is going quite well for athletes who have sports activities in the UPTD Talent Sports area of West Sumatra Province in support of the plan to improve sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD Kebakatan Sports of West Sumatra Province every year, and the determination

of areas is quite good. The more fulfilled the physical needs of sports with the development of the UPTD of West Sumatra Province's Talented Sports as a sports training area in the Education and Training Centre of West Sumatra Province. In the form of a healthy lifestyle by athletes with sports activities, it supports the implementation of development at the UPTD of West Sumatra Province's Talent Sports, which has been planned for the management of sports facilities and infrastructure for West Sumatra Province.

CONCLUSION

Based on the results of the research and discussion, the researcher can conclude the following. The management of the facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD Kebatakan Sports of the Province of West Sumatra has implemented a management process according to existing theory. In the process of planning, organising, directing, staffing, and controlling in collaboration with the regional government of West Sumatra Province for the development of sports facilities and infrastructure and improving the quality of work of PPLP employees.

The completeness of sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD of Talented Sports of West Sumatra Province in improving sports achievement at the UPTD of Talented Sports of West Sumatra Province is a positive supporting factor for the results of events that have been participated in by athletes at the UPTD of Talented Sports of West Sumatra Province.

The management of sports facilities and infrastructure at the UPTD Kebakatan Sports of West Sumatra Province for sports achievements is going quite well, with an average number of all athletes carrying out training activities according to the sport. For this reason, the management is developing sports facilities by making the area in the UPTD Kebakatan Sports of the Province of West Sumatra a place for the Centre for Sports Education and Training of the Province of West Sumatra.
